Palm Beach County 2024 Local Mitigation Strategy Adoption

The Revised Palm Beach County Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) 2024 was adopted on November 19th, 2024, by unanimous vote by the City Commission of the City of Boynton Beach.

Report Preparation and Distribution

The progress report was prepared by Lori Lehr in coordination with Juan Manzano, CRS Coordinator for the City of Boynton Beach. The Annual Report will be published on the City's Flood Information Insurance page on the City's website: <https://www.boynton-beach.org/flood-information>

Description and Implementation of Action Items

The LMS Working Group met in March, June and September of 2024. The LMS Steering Committee met in February, June, August and November of 2024. The LMS Prioritized Project List was updated and posted in the Fall of 2024. The next project submission period will be in the April – May 2025. The LMS is a living document that outlines the County's mitigation strategy for all-hazards identified as threats to Palm Beach County. In the Fall of 2024, the LMS was revised and submitted to FDEM and FEMA for approval. The Strategy was approved by both FDEM and FEMA for adoption by the communities in Palm Beach County.

The City has five top ranked projects on the 2024 Fall Prioritized Project List in the Palm Beach County LMS. Progress update on Boynton Beach projects on the Fall 2024 Prioritized Project list in the Palm Beach LMS are as follows:

	Project	Project Progress
2	Lake Boynton Estates Drainage Improvements	Project is currently in the “Capital Improvement Project” plan for design in fiscal year 2027/2028. Design, procurement and finding grant funding would take approximately 18 months, and after that time a construction contractor will be procure.
3	NW 3 rd Street-SFWMD C-16, Flood Risk Reduction/Heart of Downtown Boynton Drainage Improvements	Have received grant funding for the design portion of the project. Currently waiting for the procurement process to advertise an RFQ for the design of the project. Looking to begin construction by the end of Fiscal Year 24/25 and complete design in fiscal year 25/26.
4	Chapell Hill Drainage Improvements	RFQ for Design has been advertised for the Chapel Hill Project. Looking to provide a design consultant and begin design by the end of the current fiscal year. Design services and grant funding is expected to take 18+ months. Once the design is finished, a construction contract will be procured.
26	City of Boynton Beach Green/Gray Infrastructure Plan	Awarded the Resilient FL Program Grant to install the living shorelines along 3 intracoastal parks in the City. Currently working on getting a consultant to evaluate the area to verify the total amount of shoreline and applicable technologies before going out to bid. Anticipate starting the bidding process in summer 2026.
12	Boynton Harbor Marina Seawall Replacement	The BBCRA will be issuing an RFQ for design upon FEMA project review and acceptance under the Pre-Disaster Mitigation program. BBCRA anticipates design in FY26 with projected construction commencing in FY27. The funding is available through the House Appropriations Committee Homeland Security bill, which includes \$1.383 million for the seawall replacement project. The BBCRA will be applying for additional CPF funding in FY26.

Utilities has submitted the City's Watershed Management Plan (WMP) to Insurance Service Offices (ISO) to meet the Class 4 requirements of the Community Rating System (CRS) Program. The purpose of watershed planning is to provide a tool that can be used in decision-making to reduce flooding from future conditions which can include development/redevelopment, climate change, and sea level rise. This grant funded WMP will also provide a strong baseline for future work within the City and offers the opportunity to enhance relevant datasets, explore climate vulnerability, and modernize some of its stormwater information.

The City is currently a CRS Class 5 which means that most National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) flood insurance policy holders receive a 25% discount on their annual flood insurance premiums. The discount is a direct result of the City's floodplain management practices that are credited under a multi-tier CRS program. Having a WMP that meets the CRS program requirements will satisfy one of the CRS criteria for moving to a CRS Class 4, offering a 30% discount to NFIP flood insurance policy holders.

Recommendation for New Projects or Revised Recommendations

The LMS Prioritized Project List is updated annually, and the completed projects or obsolete projects are removed, and the recommended projects are prioritized. *Attachment 1* represents the new and revised project recommendations.
