

Play Policy

Absolute Age Restrictions - Child Safety

INFANTS, TODDLERS, AND CHILDREN UNDER AGE 5 ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED from entering any golf course area including fairways, tees, greens, cart paths, driving range, and all practice facilities. **THIS RESTRICTION IS ABSOLUTE AND NON-NEGOTIABLE.**

Golf courses contain numerous hazards including but not limited to:

- Moving golf carts and maintenance equipment
- Flying golf balls traveling at high speeds
- Water hazards and uneven terrain
- Chemical treatments and fertilizers
- Wildlife and insects

These hazards create unacceptable safety risks for infants and toddlers that cannot be mitigated through supervision.

VIOLATION OF THIS POLICY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE PREMISES.

Age and Course Requirements

- **Minimum age for Challenge Course: 5 years**
- **Minimum age for Championship Course: 8 years**
- Juniors under age 12 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) at all times while on golf course property
- **Adult supervisors are fully liable for junior golfers under their supervision**

Liability and Supervision

PARENTS AND GUARDIANS ASSUME COMPLETE LIABILITY for junior golfers and acknowledge that golf involves inherent and unavoidable risks. The City of Boynton Beach shall not be liable for any injuries, incidents, or damages involving junior golfers.

Adult supervisors must:

- Maintain direct visual supervision at all times
- Ensure junior golfers follow all safety protocols
- Accept full responsibility for any damages or injuries caused by junior golfers

- Remove junior golfers immediately upon staff request

Cart Usage and Licensing

- Juniors age 17 and under receive 50% discount on green and cart fees when accompanied by a paying adult or when walking
- Golf cart operation requires operator to be 18 years of age with a valid driver's license

Inclement Weather - Mandatory Junior Removal

ALL UNACCOMPANIED JUNIORS MUST BE IMMEDIATELY REMOVED from the golf course and all practice facilities when any inclement weather conditions arise, including but not limited to:

- Lightning in the area
- Heavy rainfall
- High winds
- Any other weather conditions deemed hazardous by staff

Juniors may return to play only after:

1. All inclement weather has completely passed
2. Staff has determined conditions are safe for resumed play
3. Parents/guardians have been notified and provide express consent for continued play

Staff reserves the absolute right to require immediate removal of any junior golfer from all premises when weather, safety, or behavioral conditions warrant such action.

Enforcement and Violations

The facility reserves the right to:

- Refuse service to anyone violating these policies
- Remove violators from the premises immediately
- Ban repeat violators from the facility
- Pursue all available legal remedies for policy violations

General Junior Golfer Liability Disclaimer

BY ALLOWING JUNIOR GOLFERS TO USE THIS FACILITY, PARENTS/GUARDIANS ACKNOWLEDGE:

- Golf is an inherently dangerous activity with unavoidable risks

- They voluntarily assume all risks on behalf of junior golfers
- They waive any claims against the City of Boynton Beach for golf-related injuries or damages
- They are fully responsible for junior golfers' actions and any resulting damages
- The City makes no warranties regarding course safety or suitability for junior play

JUNIOR GOLFERS PLAY ENTIRELY AT THEIR OWN RISK AND THE RISK OF THEIR PARENTS/GUARDIANS.
